## Prepare for service at the wing and region staff level.

### COMPLETE YOUR LEVEL IV (COMMAND AND STAFF)

This formal in-residence course, designed to help CAP officers better execute duties and responsibilities associated with Command and Staff positions at squadron level and above, is also an opportunity to improve your management skills. This is a required course for promotion to Lt Col.

You also need this training if:

- You are currently serving in a command or staff position, and/or
- You want or need a better understanding of the Civil Air Patrol organization, traditions, and know-how.

This activity will give you a letter of course completion to present to your employer, which you may also use to submit for professional development units (PDUs). Many employers will pay for you to attend such a course.

The \$150.00\* tuition (early tuition is \$135.00 if deposit is received before deadline below) includes training, books and materials, Sunday Social, Wednesday Picnic, and Saturday Dining Out/Graduation. Apply early to reserve your place at the Rocky Mountain Region Staff College, as seating is limited.

(\* In addition to the \$150.00 tuition, you will need to pay separately for billeting at Peterson AFB (approx. \$39.00/night) and for your meals in the PAFB Dining Hall (about \$10.00/day).

### EARLY ENROLLMENT DEADLINE: 30 May 2012

Apply on CAPF 17 through appropriate command channels with a \$75.00 deposit payable to RMR Staff College. **Alumni are welcome to apply for staff positions. (Serving on RMRSC Staff will meet a Level V requirement!)**
