How are our ACE Awards determined?

First, we accept nominations for our major ACE awards of National Teacher, School, and Student of the Year for the Aerospace Connections in Education (ACE) program.

• We have done the same for the ACE Plus Adopt program award submissions to select the Adopt Team of the Year.

For other ACE awards, we work as a team at the CAP National HQ in Montgomery, AL, to decide which school and/or teacher has gone above and beyond; which school coordinator has worked tirelessly to ensure all students are involved in the ACE program; and which individuals have uniquely stood out (and have kept us updated on what they are doing via photos and communications) and deserve a special recognition for the year. The special ACE awards are then selected.

• We also selected an Adopt Spirit Team awardee this year.

Points of Pride for 2021-2022

Even during a continued year of varied COVID restrictions, there were over 85,000 ACE students from 457 schools in 46 states + Europe (DoD). In addition to a variety of school types, there were Boys and Girls Clubs, after-school programs, museums and libraries, and summer camps all using the ACE program. Proudly, we had a large group of ACE Plus Adopt teams this year, as well. (See list by state HERE.)

- ➤ 98% educators view ACE as fitting well with standards; supporting STEM education; a valuable use of time; and a positive influence on behavior and learning.
- ➤ 90% of ACE schools are Title 1 Schools, therefore allowing CAP to reach a broad range of ethnicities and socio-economic demographics.

The new <u>ACE Plus Adopt program</u> expanded in its second year to have CAP squadrons connect with teachers to help teach the ACE lessons, share information about the CAP cadet program, coordinate field trips, and teach about a variety of STEM careers. Included in this year's ACE Plus Adopt program was **7 Regions**, **22 wings**, **48 teachers**, and **3,518 students**.
