SUBJECT: CAPR 76-1 Update

- 1. During a recent review of CAPR 76-1, *Civil Air Patrol Member Movement via Military Aircraft*, dated 26 Dec 12, our staff found outdated references and requirements that could cause undue confusion and unnecessary work by both CAP and CAP-USAF when requesting military airlift either for orientation flights or transportation purposes.
- 2. In light of these changes, I recommend that CAP rescind CAPR 76-1 while changes are coordinated with the CAP-USAF Airlift Validator.
- 3. Until an updated CAPR 76-1 is approved by the CAP/CC and CAP-USAF/CC, please have your Wing POCs communicate directly with their CAP-USAF Liaison Region (LR) when pursuing military airlift for either orientation flights or point to point transportation. The CAP-USAF LRs will be able to assist the Wings in completing the necessary requirements to secure airlift if available.
- 4. Since the WMIRS 1.0 module is built around outdated requirements, we recommend it also be disabled immediately and our offices can evaluate the need for a new module in the future if warranted.
