Questions?

How much does it cost? Annual membership dues vary by state, but average about \$60. You will also be responsible for any required uniform items.

What's the time commitment? On average, members meet one night a week for 2 hours. You will also have the opportunity to attend additional training, conferences and other activities.

Do I have to wear a uniform? CAP members have the privilege of wearing a uniform. The local unit will give you more information about the types of uniforms, both military and civilian, that are available.

I'm not a pilot, is there a place for me in CAP? Absolutely! Pilots are one of our most visible positions in CAP, but most volunteer members do not fly. Youth development, aerospace education, or public relations are just a few areas that you may be interested in. For more information, contact your local unit.
